

RESUME OF MRS ZODWA MANASE

Zodwa is a qualified Chartered Accountant with B.Com, B.Compt Hons from the University of South Africa and a Higher Diploma in Tax from the University of Natal.

Zodwa's financial experience commenced in 1986 with training for articles at Deloitte Haskins and Sells (now Deloitte & Touche). After her training, she held various financial management positions at Shell SA, C G Smith (Smithchem) and Spoornet.

In 1996 she left full time employment to start up the audit firm, Manase & Associates, a firm of Chartered Accountants and Business Consultants. Zodwa is the Chief Executive Officer of the firm.

In addition to running Manase & Associates, Zodwa is actively involved in ensuring the implementation of transformation, efficiency and good corporate governance in government owned entities. From 1998 to 2002, she served as a board member in the Central Energy Fund, Soekor, Mossgas and the Medical Research Council (MRC). She chaired the audit committees of these Boards and was instrumental in ensuring the implementation of the new Public Finance and Management Act (PFMA), whose main objective is to ensure that government entities are managed efficiently and effectively. She is the Chairperson of the State Information Technology Agency (SITA) and serves on the Boards of Denel and the Reserve Bank. She also chairs the audit committee of Denel, and is a member of the audit committee of the Reserve Bank.

Zodwa plays an important role helping to ensure accountability, transparency and good corporate governance in the government of South Africa. In 1998, when the audit committees were set up in government departments, Zodwa was amongst the first members of the audit committee of the then Deputy President Thabo Mbeki, she is currently a member of the audit committee of The Office The President. She was the first chairperson of the audit committee of the South African Government's National Intelligence Services from 2000 – 2003. She is the Chairperson of the audit committees of GCIS, MDDA and the IMC.

Zodwa is a member of the following professional bodies: Public Auditors and Accountants Board (PAAB); South African Institute of Chartered Accountants (SAICA) and the Association for the Advancement of Accountants in Southern Africa (ABASA). She has also filled leadership positions as the Chairperson for the Association for the Advancement of Accountants in Southern Africa (ABASA (Kwa-Zulu Natal) (1994 – 1995) and as a council member for the Eastern Central and Southern African Federation of Accountants (ECASAFA) (1996 – 1998).
